We hope you are enjoying the warmer weather as much as we are. If you are working outside burning slash, please remember to keep a close eye on your burn pile. Have a water source and tools handy, watch the wind, and if your fire gets away from you, call 9-1-1 and we will come give you a hand. Burn season is still open but permits for slash piles will be required from May 10-October 20. Burn permits are free and can be found at <https://burnpermits.idaho.gov/Home.aspx>
